The Litchfield School Board is made up of five community members elected for a three-year term. There are three schools in the community of Litchfield that provide educational services to our students. Griffin Memorial School serves students in grades PreK-4. Litchfield Middle School serves students in grades 5-8. Campbell High School serves students in grades 9-12. The student population is 1,309 students whom are served by 300 employees.

Qualifications for the position include:

- Minimum of 10 years in public education, five of which will be in administration
- Completion of an advanced degree in Education Leadership (Masters or higher). Studies shall include School Finance, Personnel, School Planning, Curriculum, Public Relations, School Law, Administration, Business Management and Supervision.
- Current NH Superintendent of Schools Certification or eligible for Superintendent certification by the State of NH
