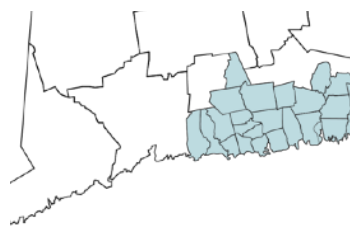

- ◆ A minimum of three recent letters of professional reference.
- ◆ Undergraduate and graduate transcripts and a copy of professional certification.

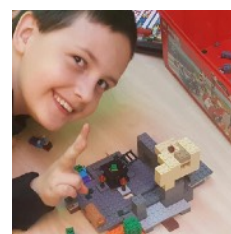
