- *Right to Know law, budgeting, strategic planning, roles and responsibilities and numerous other areas of school board governance.*

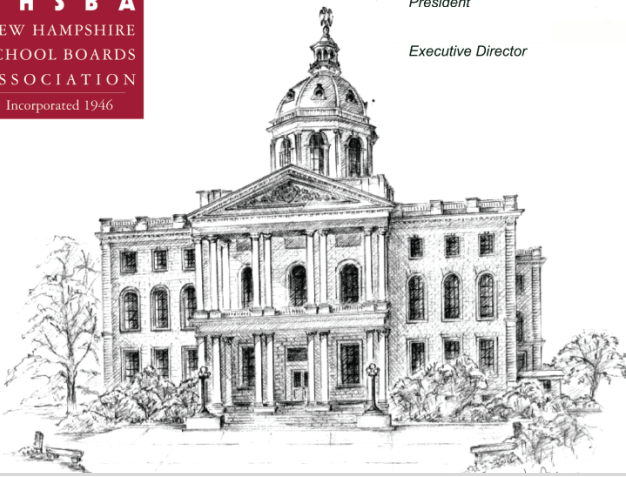
