Bangor High School offers 22 Advanced Placement classes (which consistently outperform state and national scores) and has four Academies for students who wish to pursue a deeper concentration in <u>STEM</u>, <u>Visual and Performing Arts</u>, <u>Business</u>, or <u>Humanities</u>.
